Our Order. The Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic, family, fraternal service (a 501(c)(8)) benefit organization, with approximately 1.9 million members. We donate approximately \$175 million to other charitable causes and we donate over 70 million hours of volunteer services to our Church (to include pro-life & vocations, our families, our youth, and our communities).

Our Council. Corona Council 3687 was chartered on the 6th of April 1953, at St. Edward's Catholic Church in Corona, California. As the Catholic population grew, the council has a rich history of serving the four parishes in Corona - Corpus Christi, St. Mary Magdalene, St. Matthew's, and St. Edward until Corpus Christi formed their own council (13180) in 2002 and a new council was established at St. Edward's in 2008 (Bishop Dennis P. O'Neil Council 14292). Corona Council 3687 then moved to St. Mary Magdalene in 2008 to support and service that parish. Currently, Corona Council 3687 has 177 members.

Our Tournament. In 1996, Past Grand Knight Jerry German passed away as a result of a battle with pancreatic cancer. To honor him, the council launched it's first memorial charity golf tournament to raise funds for the council, so that they could make a significant charitable donation to the American Cancer Society, as well as other charities the council supported. In 2014, the council changed its cancer organization to the St. Joseph Hospital-Center for Cancer Prevention and Treatment, to be more aligned to the values of the council and the Order.
